Lifecycle of Reviews (LOR) (Planning)	ICANN org initiated the Lifecycle of Reviews Project to understand the current operational challenges faced by Specific Reviews and introduce procedural improvements to the reviews process. This is a continuation of the work started by the OEC; this work was paused while the ATRT3 was active. ICANN org has compiled identified problems and proposed improvements to the ICANN review program as articulated by the community, Board and ICANN org over the past five years, which manifested into a Thought Paper outlining the current state of the reviews process and providing an overview of potential improvements.
