



Dear MoSAPI Users,

We are writing to inform you that a new version of the Monitoring System API (MoSAPI) Specification was published on 26/05/2026. The updates detailed in the new MoSAPI Specification are scheduled for production in late June 2026.

This new version contains two major changes:

1. The current data retention policy for MoSAPI incident data is indefinite. The incident data is defined in Section 5 of the MoSAPI Specification. As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance system performance, ICANN will update the online availability retention period for this data to 365 calendar days, effective 19 June 2026..

After this update, incident data older than 365 days will no longer be available through MoSAPI.

To preserve incident data beyond the 365-day online availability period, you must download and store the data locally before it expires from MoSAPI.

The retention periods for all MoSAPI endpoints are described in Section 1.5 of the MoSAPI Specification.

2. Additionally, the “targetIP” element within the “nameServerAvailability” object is currently missing for the MoSAPI measurements, as described in Section 5.8.

Following this version update, the “targetIP” element will be included in the “nameServerStatus” and “testData” objects within the “nameServerAvailability” object of the MoSAPI measurements.
