



Dear ICANN-Accredited Registrar,

Each year, the ICANN organization requests your approval of the variable accreditation fees established by the ICANN Board of Directors for the fiscal year. The time to vote is here again and we encourage your participation to ensure your voice is heard. Please refer to the Registrar's Fee section detailed on pages 39-41 of the [ICANN FY27 Budget](#) and summarized below regarding these fees.

Variable Accreditation Fees:

- The per-transaction fee is USD 0.20 per transaction/year.
- The variable shared registrar fee is USD 3.8 million per year, divided amongst all registrars, with forgiveness automatically granted to qualified registrars.

A "Yes" vote means that you support the variable accreditation fees established by the ICANN Board of Directors for FY27. If an affirmative vote is achieved (by registrars accounting, in the aggregate, for payment of two-thirds of all registrar-level fees), ICANN org will continue directly billing registrars for the same amount of variable accreditation fees as last fiscal year and as detailed above.

A "No" vote means that you do not support the variable accreditation fees established by the ICANN Board of Directors for FY26. If an affirmative vote is not achieved, ICANN org will bill registry operators the variable accreditation fees as described above and registry operators may invoice and collect these fees directly from registrars per Section [6.3\(a\)](#) of the Registry Agreement.

In the next few hours, you will receive an invitation from a secure online voting platform. The email will be sent from noreply@eballot.com and we suggest you add their email to your safe-sender list.

Voting will close at 23:59 UTC on 10 July 2026.
