11. Competition Effects

We do not believe the proposed service would have any effects on competition as this simply expands the choice of domains in a competitive market. The proposed service consists of adopting the ICANN-published Second-Level Reference LGRs for Latin (und-Latn), Portuguese (pt), and Spanish (es) for use at the second level of the .latino gTLD when it launches in 2026

12. Market Definition

The proposed service competes in the global domain name registry services market, which includes legacy gTLDs, new gTLDs, IDN gTLDs, and relevant ccTLDs. Domain names across TLDs are substitutable from a registrant perspective. The geographic market is global, as

domain names are marketed and distributed worldwide through ICANN-accredited registrars. The proposed IDN tables do not create a new market but expand label options within the existing competitive framework. The adoption of the Latin (und-Latn), Portuguese (pt), and Spanish (es) Reference LGRs allows .latino to support domain names that accurately reflect linguistic conventions used across these communities that are already served by existing domains, providing more choice to registrants.

13. Companies Providing Similar Services or Products

Global gTLD Registry Operators

These operators manage top-level domains where registrants can register domain names substitutable with .latino: Verisign – operates legacy gTLDs including .com and .net, supporting IDN registrations in Latin script. Public Interest Registry (PIR) – operates .org, which also supports Latin-script registrations. Google Registry – operates multiple gTLDs (e.g., .app, .dev, .page). Identity Digital – operates a large portfolio of new gTLDs across many categories and many other gTLD operators.

In the RA Amendment Execution phase, ICANN org will open an additional case to process the execution of the RA Amendment and provide you with the case number.

14. Competition Ability of Other Companies

No. The introduction of the proposed service would not impair the ability of other registry operators or entities providing similar services to compete.

The proposed service consists solely of adopting ICANN-published Second-Level Reference LGRs for Latin (und-Latn), Portuguese (pt), and Spanish (es) to enable additional IDN registrations under the .latino gTLD. These language repertoires and scripts are already supported by numerous other gTLDs and ccTLDs.

No, the Registry Operator has not conducted direct communications with other registry operators, registrars, or entities that may provide similar services in connection with the proposed service. The proposed service consists solely of adopting ICANN-published Second-Level Reference LGRs for Latin (und-Latn), Portuguese (pt), and Spanish (es). These Reference LGRs were developed through ICANN's established community processes and public consultations. This does not impact competitive conditions. Therefore no direct communications were necessary.
