

Dear Registry Operator,

As previewed in late October, ICANN is adjusting the fees charged to registries for the first time in over a decade. This adjustment is part of our efforts to ensure ICANN's financial sustainability, allowing us to continue performing our mission for the benefit of the Internet community.

This letter serves as formal notice that, effective January 1, 2025, the quarterly fixed fees and per-domain transaction fees will increase by 3.0%, as contemplated by your Registry Agreement (RA) with ICANN.

Below is an illustration of the fee adjustment:

| Fee Type                    | Current Fee                 | Adjusted Fee (Effective 1 January 2025) |
|-----------------------------|-----------------------------|-----------------------------------------|
| Quarterly Fixed Fees        | \$6,250                     | \$6,437.50                              |
| Per-Domain Transaction Fees | \$0.25 per transaction/year | \$0.2575 per transaction/year           |

No further action is required from your side, as ICANN will reflect these adjustments in your billings beginning in January 2025. ICANN retains the right to make similar adjustments in subsequent years.

For your information, ICANN also plans to adjust the registrar-level variable accreditation fees in accordance with the processes set out in the 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement.
