Thank you for your message of [13 May 2026](#).

We have taken note of your decision not to withdraw your application 1-1873-71868 for .IDN, and thereby forfeiting your eligibility to request a refund associated with your application, per our [communication](#) of 1 May 2026. We will now proceed to move your application to "terminated" status per the process [approved](#) by the ICANN Board.

We note the information you provided regarding your proposal for a .INTERNET TLD. As previously stated "although ICANN is sympathetic to the fact that Nameshop wishes to operate a .INTERNET gTLD and has stated that it intends to do so in the best interest of ICANN and the community, there are simply no further avenues [as part of the 2012 Round] to delegation for Nameshop to pursue at this time."
