I. Introduction

I write to you formally regarding my case (**Namecheap Ticket ID: NC-UWS-6390; ICANN Compliance Case: #01448650**), which has been documented in a public thread now viewed by over **20,600+ witnesses**.

An expert in that thread drew a clear line:

Scam = Deception + Financial Gain.

I invite you to examine the documented pattern in my case:

Based on the documented evidence—including the four emails from ICANN Compliance claiming "**no authority,**" the ICANN CEO's transcript confirming "**we instructed,**" **the shifting audit dates (August 2023 vs. October 2023), the 553 days of silence between deletion and discovery, the auto-renew enabled, and the 5 months of unused service with no refund**—and based on the expert definition provided in the thread:
