**Outcome:**

ICANN org appreciates the comments submitted by the community on the Proposal for Thaana script Root Zone Label Generation Rules. ICANN org received five comments on the proposal. Three comments are in support of the proposal. One comment is in support and suggests some improvement to the proposal. One comment has no concerns with the proposal.

These comments will be submitted to the Thaana Script Generation Panel (GP) for their consideration and incorporation as needed. ## Section 1: What We Received Input On

Root Zone Label Generation Rules (RZ-LGRs) define a conservative mechanism to determine valid Internationalized Domain Name (IDN) top-level domains (TLDs) and their variant labels. The successful development of RZ-LGR depends on having community-based Generation Panels (GPs) develop proposals for their script(s).

The Thaana Script GP has finalized the proposal for Thaana script RZ-LGR. The proposal was published for Public Comment before its finalization and submission to the Integration Panel for review and possible integration into the next version of the RZ-LGR.

## Section 3: Summary of Submissions

ICANN org received five comments on the Proposal for Thaana Script Root Zone Label Generation Rules.

The Registries Stakeholder Group (RySG) appreciates the opportunity to review and comment on the proposed Thaana script RZ-LGR and further comments that it has no concerns with the proposal.

The comment from Naail Abdul Rahman (NA) indicates that the current proposal offers good coverage for the label generation for the root zone and supports the proposal.

Abdulla Samir (AS) supports the current proposal. Further, Ahmed Afrah Ismail (AA) comments that the proposal provides a good baseline and sufficient technical input.

The comment from Benson Mugure (BM) supports the proposal and suggests that the proposal can be enhanced by including more detail for code point inclusion/exclusion criteria, providing a more explicit analysis of cross-script variant, and presenting a formal specification of the rules governing valid Thaana root zone labels.
