ICANN Final Determination

Re: Notice of Registry Operator Request for Termination of Registry Agreement .cancerresearch

On 11 April 2022, Australian Cancer Research Foundation notified ICANN org of its intent to terminate the .cancerresearch Registry Agreement entered into on 15 May 2014. Pursuant to Section 4.4(b) of the Registry Agreement, Registry Operator may terminate the Registry Agreement for any reason upon one hundred eighty (180) calendar day advance notice.

Pursuant to the terms of Section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement, ICANN org consulted with Australian Cancer Research Foundation to assess whether to transition operation of the .cancerresearch top-level domain (TLD) to a successor Registry Operator.

On 15 July 2022, ICANN org made a preliminary determination that operation of the .cancerresearch TLD need not be transitioned to a successor Registry Operator based on the following rationale:

ICANN org's review and determination regarding transition to a successor registry are subject to Section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement and are based on various factors, including ICANN org's assessment that transitioning the TLD is not necessary to protect the public interest. The Registry Operator attested that all domain name registrations have at all times been registered to and maintained by the Registry Operator or its affiliates for their exclusive use and Registry Operator has not at any time sold, distributed, or transferred control or use of any registrations in the .cancerresearch TLD to any third party that is not an affiliate.

On 14 August 2022, after a 30-day period for comments by interested parties, no comments were received. Pursuant to Section 4.4(b) of the Registry Agreement, ICANN org will proceed to terminate the .cancerresearch Registry Agreement by 8 October 2022.
