

Amendment No. 2 to the .INFO Registry Agreement

The Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers and Afiliis Limited agree, effective as of _____ (“Amendment Effective Date”), that the following modification is made to the 22 August 2013 .INFO Registry Agreement (“Agreement”):

1. The Parties agree to amend Appendix 6 of the Agreement by deleting section C in its entirety:

[OLD TEXT]

C. Tagged Domain Names. All labels with hyphens in the third and fourth character positions (e.g., "bq--1k2n4h4b" or "xn--ndk061n").

[END OLD TEXT]

The Parties further agree to amend Appendix 6 of the Agreement by replacing the deleted section above with new text as a new section C:

[START NEW TEXT]

C. Tagged Domain Names. All DNS labels with hyphens in the third and fourth character positions (e.g., "bq--1k2n4h4b"), with the exception of DNS labels that represent valid IDNs in their ASCII encoding (e.g., "xn--ndk061n").

2. The Parties agree to amend Appendix 9 of the Agreement by deleting the following text in its entirety:

[OLD TEXT]

- Internationalized Domain Names, in accordance with the Letter to Ram Mohan from Paul Twomey dated 19 August 2003; and

The Parties further agree to amend Appendix 9 of the Agreement by adding a new section:

[START NEW TEXT]

- **Internationalized Domain Names (IDNs)**

Registry Operator may offer registration of IDNs at the second and lower levels provided that Registry Operator complies with the following requirements:

- I. Registry Operator must offer Registrars support for handling IDN registrations in EPP.
- II. Registry Operator must handle variant IDNs as follows:

- i. By default variant IDNs (as defined in the Registry Operator's IDN tables and IDN Registration Rules) must be blocked from registration.
 - ii. Variant IDNs may be activated when requested by the sponsoring Registrar of the canonical name as described in the IDN Tables and IDN Registration Rules.
 - iii. Active variant IDNs must be provisioned in the TLD's DNS zone file as zone cuts using the same NS resource records as the canonical name.
- III. Registry Operator may offer registration of IDNs in the following languages/scripts (IDN Tables and IDN Registration Rules will be published by the Registry Operator as specified in the ICANN IDN Implementation Guidelines):
 - i. Arabic language
 - ii. Belarusian language
 - iii. Bosnian language
 - iv. Bulgarian language
 - v. Chinese (Simplified) language
 - vi. Chinese (Traditional) language
 - vii. Danish language
 - viii. Finnish language
 - ix. French language
 - x. German language
 - xi. Hindi language
 - xii. Hungarian language
 - xiii. Icelandic language
 - xiv. Italian language
 - xv. Korean language
 - xvi. Latvian language
 - xvii. Lithuanian language
 - xviii. Macedonian language
 - xix. Montenegrin language
 - xx. Polish language
 - xxi. Portuguese language

- xxii. Russian language
- xxiii. Serbian language
- xxiv. Spanish language
- xxv. Swedish language
- xxvi. Ukrainian language

3. The parties agree that, except as set forth herein, and any prior duly authorized and executed amendments, the current terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. All capitalized terms not defined herein will have the meaning given to them in the Agreement.
