Despite the terms of Section 3.2 of Specification 5, Registry Operator may not release any such name for registration to another person or entity. In the event any label listed in Attachment 1 to Exhibit A is changed from "Unassigned" to any other status in the ISO 3166-1 alpha-2 standard, Registry Operator must deactivate all related names that are active in the DNS.
The parties agree that, except as set forth in this Amendment, the current terms of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect. All capitalized terms not defined will have the meaning given to them in the Agreement.
