ICANN Final Determination

Re: Notice of Registry Operator Request for Termination of Registry Agreement - .juniper

On 08 June 2026, JUNIPER NETWORKS, INC. notified ICANN org of its intent to terminate the .juniper Registry Agreement entered into on 30 July 2015. Pursuant to Section 4.4(b) of the Registry Agreement, Registry Operator may terminate the Registry Agreement for any reason upon one hundred eighty (180) calendar day advance notice.

Pursuant to the terms of Section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement (as modified by Section 6 of Specification 13 for this .Brand TLD), ICANN org consulted with JUNIPER NETWORKS, INC. to assess whether to transition operation of the .juniper top-level domain (TLD) to a successor Registry Operator.

On 20 July 2026, ICANN org made a preliminary determination that operation of the .juniper TLD need not be transitioned to a successor Registry Operator based on the following rationale:

1. .juniper qualifies as a .Brand TLD.
2. Transitioning the TLD is not necessary to protect the public interest.

On 19 August 2026, after a 30-day period for comments by interested parties, no comments were received. Pursuant to Section 4.4(b) of the Registry Agreement, ICANN org will proceed to terminate the .juniper Registry Agreement no later than 05 December 2026.

In conformance with Section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement (as modified by Section 6 of Specification 13 for this .Brand TLD), ICANN org may not delegate the TLD to a successor registry operator for a period of two years without Registry Operator's consent, which shall not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned or delayed.

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
