ICANN Final Determination Re: Notice of Registry Operator Request for Termination of Registry Agreement - .kinder

On 25 May 2023, Ferrero Trading Lux S.A. notified ICANN org of its intent to terminate the .kinder Registry Agreement entered into on 07 November 2014. Pursuant to Section 4.4(b) of the Registry Agreement, Registry Operator may terminate the Registry Agreement for any reason upon one hundred eighty (180) calendar day advance notice.

Pursuant to the terms of Section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement (as modified by Section 6 of Specification 13 for this .Brand TLD), ICANN org consulted with Ferrero Trading Lux S.A. to assess whether to transition operation of the .kinder top-level domain (TLD) to a successor Registry Operator.

On 22 August 2023, ICANN org made a preliminary determination that operation of the .kinder TLD need not be transitioned to a successor Registry Operator based on the following rationale:

- 1. .kinder qualifies as a .Brand TLD.
- 2. Transitioning the TLD is not necessary to protect the public interest.

On 21 September 2023, after a 30-day period for comments by interested parties, no comments were received. Pursuant to Section 4.4(b) of the Registry Agreement, ICANN org will proceed to terminate the .kinder Registry Agreement by 21 November 2023.

In conformance with Section 4.5 of the Registry Agreement (as modified by Section 6 of Specification 13 for this .Brand TLD), ICANN org may not delegate the TLD to a successor registry operator for a period of two years without Registry Operator's consent, which shall not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned or delayed.
