Dear Registry Operator,

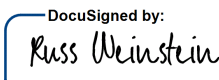
The top-level domains (TLDs) listed in Appendix A are part of the New gTLD Program initiative that expanded the top level domain space, created greater consumer choice, enhanced competition, and provided a robust platform for innovation.

It's been 10 years of operations and pursuant to Article 4 of the Registry Agreements between the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers and Registry Operator, the Registry Agreements will be renewed for a successive 10-year period beginning on the corresponding dates noted in Appendix A (each date, a "Successive Term Start Date"). ICANN reserves the right not to permit renewal of any of the Registry Agreements in the event any of the exceptions set forth in [Section 4.2](#) of each Registry Agreement apply on the corresponding Successive Term Start Date. For clarity, none of the terms of the Registry Agreements will change as a result of these renewals; and re-execution of the Registry Agreements are not necessary. ICANN will soon publish this letter to the Registry Agreement webpages.

ICANN appreciates that, as a registry operator, you manage a piece of the Internet infrastructure. My team continues to be available to support and collaborate with you to ensure a secure, stable and resilient TLD namespace.
