



## .NET FEE SCHEDULE

EFFECTIVE 1 FEBRUARY 2017

In accordance with the terms and conditions of the 1 July 2011 Registry Agreement (“Agreement”) executed between VeriSign, Inc. (“Verisign”) and the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (“ICANN”) for the .NET top-level domain (“TLD”), Verisign has provided effective notice of a price increase for certain registration service fees set forth in Exhibit A of Appendix 8 of the Agreement.

Effective as of 1 February 2017, the fees for specified services are listed below (change indicated in ***bold/italics***):
