

## **Amendment No. 1 to Registry Agreement**

The Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers and Public Interest Registry agree, effective as of \_\_\_\_\_ (“Amendment No. 1 Effective Date”), that the modification set forth in this amendment No. 1 (the “Amendment”) is made to the 30 June 2019 .org Registry Agreement between the parties, as amended (the “Agreement”).

The parties hereby agree to amend Exhibit A of the Agreement by deleting the following section 4 in its entirety:

### **“4. Internationalized Domain Names (IDNs)**

Registry Operator may offer registration of IDNs at the second and lower levels provided that Registry Operator complies with the following requirements:

- 4.1.** Registry Operator must offer Registrars support for handling IDN registrations in EPP.
- 4.2.** Registry Operator must handle variant IDNs as follows:
  - 4.2.1.** Variant IDNs (as defined in the Registry Operator’s IDN tables and IDN Registration Rules) will be blocked from registration.
- 4.3.** Registry Operator may offer registration of IDNs in the following languages/scripts (IDN Tables and IDN Registration Rules will be published by the Registry Operator as specified in the ICANN IDN Implementation Guidelines):

All capitalized terms not defined will have the meaning given to them in the Agreement. This Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of such counterparts taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
