

Amendment no. 3 to the .POST Sponsored TLD Agreement

This Amendment no. 3 (hereinafter the "Amendment no. 3") to the .POST Sponsored TLD Agreement dated 11 December 2009 (hereinafter the "Agreement") and further amended on 3 October 2012 (hereinafter the "Amendment no. 1") and on 29 October 2015 (hereinafter the "Amendment no. 2") is entered into by and between the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation (hereinafter "ICANN") and the Universal Postal Union, a specialized agency of the United Nations having its headquarters at Weltpoststrasse 4, 3015 Berne, Switzerland (hereinafter the "UPU" or "Sponsor") and with effect from 31 July 2022. ICANN and the UPU may also be individually referred to as "Party", or collectively as "Parties".

The Parties hereby agree to amend Section 4.1 of the Agreement by deleting and replacing the first sentence of Section 4.1 of the Agreement in its entirety as follows:

The initial term of this Agreement shall be from the Effective Date until 3 April 2024 (the "Expiration Date").

Each Party hereby acknowledges and agrees that this Amendment no. 3 shall not be construed as a waiver of any provision of the Agreement, Amendment no. 1, or Amendment no. 2 by any Party hereto, nor shall it in any way affect the validity of, or the right of any Party hereto, to enforce the provisions of the Agreement, Amendment no. 1, or Amendment no. 2. The Parties agree that, except as set forth in this Amendment no. 3 and any prior duly authorized and executed amendments, the current terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect. All capitalized terms not defined will have the meaning given to them in the Agreement, Amendment no. 1, or Amendment no. 2. This Amendment no. 3 may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of such counterparts taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
