

Amendment no. 6 to the .POST Sponsored TLD Agreement

This Amendment no. 6 (hereinafter the “Amendment no. 6”) to the .POST Sponsored TLD Agreement dated 11 December 2009 (hereinafter the “Agreement”), as further amended on 3 October 2012, on 29 October 2015, on 11 October 2022, on 1 April 2024, and on 8 January 2025, is entered into by and between the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation (hereinafter “ICANN”) and the Universal Postal Union, a specialized agency of the United Nations having its headquarters at Weltpoststrasse 4, 3015 Berne 15, Switzerland (hereinafter the “UPU” or “Sponsor”) and with effect from the date of the last signature by the Parties below. ICANN and the UPU may also be referred to individually as “Party”, or collectively as “Parties.”

The Parties hereby agree to amend Appendix S of the Agreement by deleting and replacing Section 4 of Part VIII of Appendix S in its entirety as follows:

4. Sponsor may offer registration of IDNs in the following languages/scripts (IDN Tables and IDN Registration Rules will be published by the Sponsor as specified in the ICANN IDN Implementation Guidelines):

- i. Arabic language
- ii. Chinese (Simplified + Traditional) language
- iii. Spanish language

Each Party hereby acknowledges and agrees that this Amendment no. 6 shall not be construed as a waiver of any provision of the Agreement, as amended, by any Party hereto, nor shall it in any way affect the validity of, or the right of any Party hereto, to enforce the provisions of the Agreement, as amended. The Parties agree that, except as set forth in this Amendment no. 6 and any prior duly authorized and executed amendments, the current terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect. All capitalized terms not defined will have the meaning given to them in the Agreement, as amended. This Amendment no. 6 may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of such counterparts taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
