



Public Comment on Registration Data Consensus Policy for gTLDs

The Internet Infrastructure Coalition (i2Coalition) appreciates the opportunity to comment on Registration Data Consensus Policy for gTLDs.

The i2Coalition would like to express support for the drafted Data Consensus Policy for gTLDs. This is a necessary step in properly aligning ICANN and contracted parties with the requirements of the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation. Alongside ICANN Org's review of policies and procedures as per EPDP-TempSpec Phase 1 Recommendation 27, this signals important progress, in moving toward stable footing with an actual Consensus Policy.

The i2Coalition's diverse membership represents both large and small Internet infrastructure providers such as web hosting companies, software services providers, data centers, registrars and registries.
